This Invitation for Prequalification follows the General Procurement Notice for this project which was published on the EBRD website, *Project Procurement Notices* (<http://www.ebrd.com/work-with-us/procurement/notices.html>) on 11/03/2022.

A new round of prequalification of suppliers for the natural gas is expected to begin on 18 May 2022.

Applicants that have been prequalified and/or conditionally prequalified under the original prequalification exercise carried out under this project will retain their prequalification status and do not need to resubmit their applications.

The Government of Moldova has applied for a loan from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (the Bank) and intends using part of the proceeds towards the cost of natural gas. The procurement process will be undertaken in accordance with the EBRD's Procurement Policies and Rules (PP&Rs).

Prequalification and tendering for contracts to be financed with the proceeds of a loan from the Bank is open to firms and joint ventures of firms from any country.
